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Falcons week 3 injury report

Week 2 was like a nightmare for a lot of teams and players, the Falcons were no exception. Player after player left games last Sunday with injuries that will keep them out for weeks, if not throughout the season. While no Atlanta Falcons player has been placed on the season-deciding IR and no one is officially out this week (yet), some guys should just sit down. The biggest name that could come this week is Julio Jones. Julio has missed only three games since the start of the 2015 season, but he hasn't practiced all week. At 31, the Falcons should sideline Julio until he's 100 percent. Yes, 70 percent Julio is still better than most receivers in the league, but there's no point in forcing Julio to take the field unless he can be 100 percent himself. If the league is about player safety, this should be a requirement across the board. The Atlanta Falcons secondary will have to wait another week for help. The Falcons have been without Kendall Sheffield so far and the secondary pays the price. Although he's not an All-Pro-caliber player, he's better than what the Falcons have gotten from both Isaiah Oliver and Darqueze Dennard. The Falcons desperately need him back. He hasn't practiced yet this season and 0-2 is in no hurry to get back on the field, they should wait until he's 100 percent. The biggest loss in Week 3 to the Atlanta Falcons could be both Takk McKinley and Dante Fowler. The defensive line has been a huge bright spot this season. Russell Wilson and Dak Prescott couldn't sit back and pick up the defense apart, they had to make plays on the run and unfortunately the secondary allowed it. Neither of them has practiced this week. Up next: The Falcons must dispose of black in black uniforms The Falcons are hopeful they can get rookie Marlon Davidson on the field for the first time in 2020. One of Davidson's best assets is his versatility – he can play inside and out and would be very useful this week if Takk and Fowler were both out. The Falcons' official injury report from Sunday should be out Friday afternoon. The Las Vegas Raiders (6-4) visit the Atlanta Falcons (3-7) at Mercedes-Benz Stadium on Sunday, November 29, 2020. He has appeared in 70 percent of the team's 10 games this season. Erik Harris – SS: Questionable (Calf) Harris is questionable to play against the Falcons. In the Raiders' 10 games this season, he has 43 tackles and three passes defended. Jalen Richard – RB: Questionable (Chest) Richard is questionable and unlikely to play against the Falcons. He has put 83 rushing yards on 14 and scored one touchdown in nine games this year. Alec Ingold – FB: Questionable (Ribs) Ingold is questionable and unlikely to play against the Falcons. He's put in 2 rushing yards in two of 10 games this year. Josh Jacobs – RB: Questionable (Hip) Raiders leading rusher Jacobs could be out this week because he's questionable against the Falcons. Jacobs has rushed for 754 yards on 199 attempts for nine touchdowns, carrying a load of 56.2% of the team's ground game in 10 games this year. He has also grabbed 24 passes for 158 yards (15.8 per game) and is 24.7% of the team's total offense. Amik Robertson – CB: Questionable (illness) Robertson is questionable for the Raiders-Falcons game. In six games this season, he has four tackles. Richie Incognito – G: Inactive (Achilles) Incognito will not play against the Falcons after being ruled out. He has played in 20% of the team's 10 games this season. Theo Riddick – RB: Inactive (illness) Riddick is out and won't play against the Falcons. He has put 13 rushing yards on two attempts in two games this year. Lamarcus Joyner – FS: Passive (illness) Joyner is against the Falcons. Raiders 10 This season he has 46 tackles, five TFL and three passes defended. Nick O'Leary – TE: Passive (Heart) Raiders don't have O'Leary O'Leary It's a game against the Falcons. Through 10 games this season, he has zero catches (zero goals). Trent Brown – OT: Inactive (illness) Brown will not play against the Falcons after being ruled out. He has played in 60% of the team's 10 games this season. Maliek Collins – DT: Inactive (illness) Collins is out of the game against the Falcons. He has played in nine games this year and made 13 tackles. Falcons injury impact (11/27) Julio Jones – WR: Questionable (Hamstring) Falcons assistant receiver is questionable against the Raiders, so the team may have to look elsewhere for the 22.6% passing game produced by Jones. Through eight games this season, he has 45 catches (58 touchdowns) for 677 yards (84.6 ypg) with three touchdowns. James Carpenter – G: Questionable (Groin) Carpenter has been found questionable and may not play against the Raiders. He has appeared in all 10 games for the team this season. Dante Fowler Jr. – OLB: Questionable (Hamstring) Fowler is questionable in a matchup with the Raiders and may not play. He has appeared in nine games for the Falcons this year and has put in two sacks, three TFL and 16

tackles. Todd Gurley II – RB: Questionable (Knee) Falcons leading rusher Gurley could be out this week because he's questionable against the Raiders. Gurley has rushed for 610 yards on 167 of nine touchdowns and carried a load of 60.2% of the team's rushing game in 10 games this year. Edmond Robinson – OLB: Questionable (Hamstring) Robinson has been found questionable in the Falcons' game against the Raiders. He has collected four tackles in seven games this season. Grady Jarrett – DT: Questionable (Knee) Jarrett is questionable for a matchup with the Raiders and may not play. He has appeared in 10 games for the Falcons this year and has put in three sacks, five TFL and 38 tackles. Calvin Ridley - WR: Questionable (foot) Falcons productive receiver is questionable against the Raiders, so the team may have to look elsewhere for ridley producing 24.9% of the passing game. Through nine games this season, he has 48 catches (77 touchdowns) for 747 yards (83.0 ypg) for six touchdowns. Hayden Hurst – TE: Questionable (Ankle) Falcons may not have Hurst available for the game against the Raiders because he's questionable in the competition. In 10 games this season, he has 37 catches (56 touchdowns) for 411 yards (41.1 ypg) for three touchdowns. Foyesade Oluokun – ILB: Questionable (Knee) Oluokun has been found questionable during the Falcons' game against the Raiders. He has 69 tackles, three TFL, one sack and one interception in nine games this season. Qadree Ollison – RB: Questionable (Ankle) Ollison is questionable to play against the Raiders. He's put 3 rushing yards on one try in three games this year. Mykal Walker – LB: Questionable (Hamstring) Walker is questionable in the Falcons' game against the Raiders. He is. Is. 28 tackles and one TFL in 10 games this season. Laquon Treadwell – WR: Inactive (illness) The Falcons don't have Treadwell in the game against the Raiders. In one game this season, he has zero catches (with zero goals). Damontae Kazee – SS: Passive (Achilles) Kazee is against the Raiders. In four games for the Falcons this season, he has 20 tackles.
